#84/20 640 HILL PROJECT OVERAGE:

Mills – The approved contract for the 640 Hill Rebuild project is based on 4250 meters cubed of waste excavation and 6,150 square meters of slope disturbance however the actual amount of waste excavated is estimated to be 15,500 meters cubed with a slope disturbance of 9,300 square meters. The Engineers are proposing an increase to the project costs in the amount of \$136,100. The Rural Municipality of Cupar #218 has rejected that offer and is asking the Engineer to negotiate with the Contractor.
