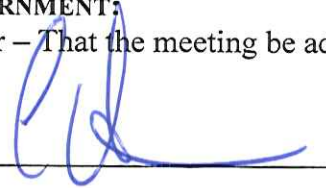
#95/26 BYLAW TO PERMANENTLY CLOSE A ROAD:

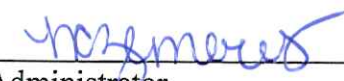
